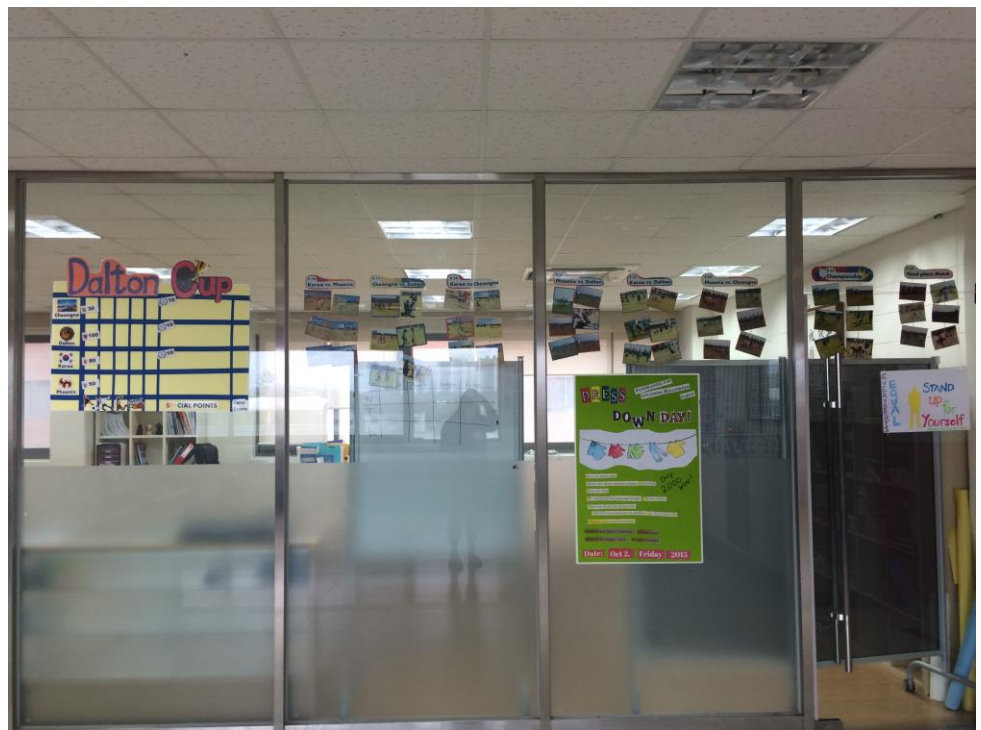
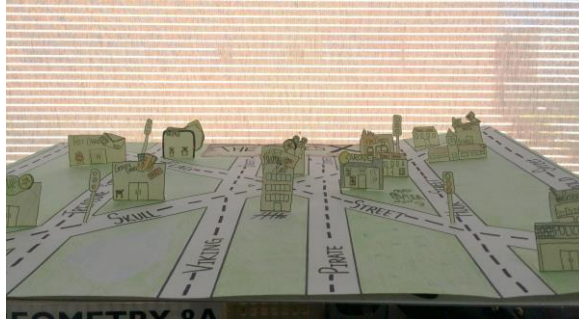
Dalton Distinguished. Congratulations!
