

The AMC 8 (American Mathematics Competitions) is an annual examination in the US that recognizes and rewards excellence in mathematics for students in grade 8 and below. It is a 25-question multiple-choice contest and its goal is to increase interest in mathematics through challenging students with critical-thinking problems and rewarding top score students with certificates and pins. As students of an international school, 28 5th to 8th grade students at Cheongna Dalton School participated in the examination on Tuesday, November 17th. Not only are these students high-achieving math students in their math classes, but they also hold a concrete foundation of mathematics and prepared well for the 2015 AMC 8 with examinations from previous years. 
